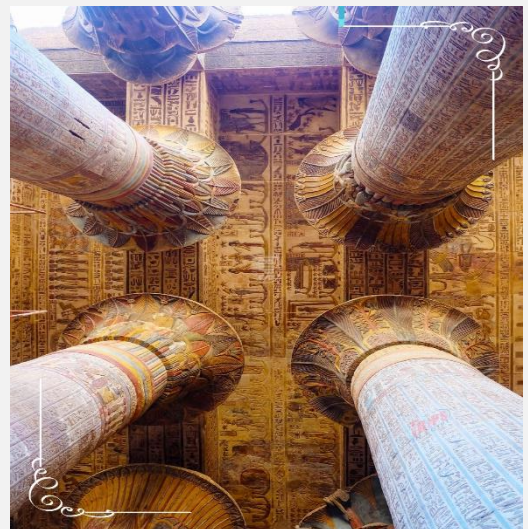

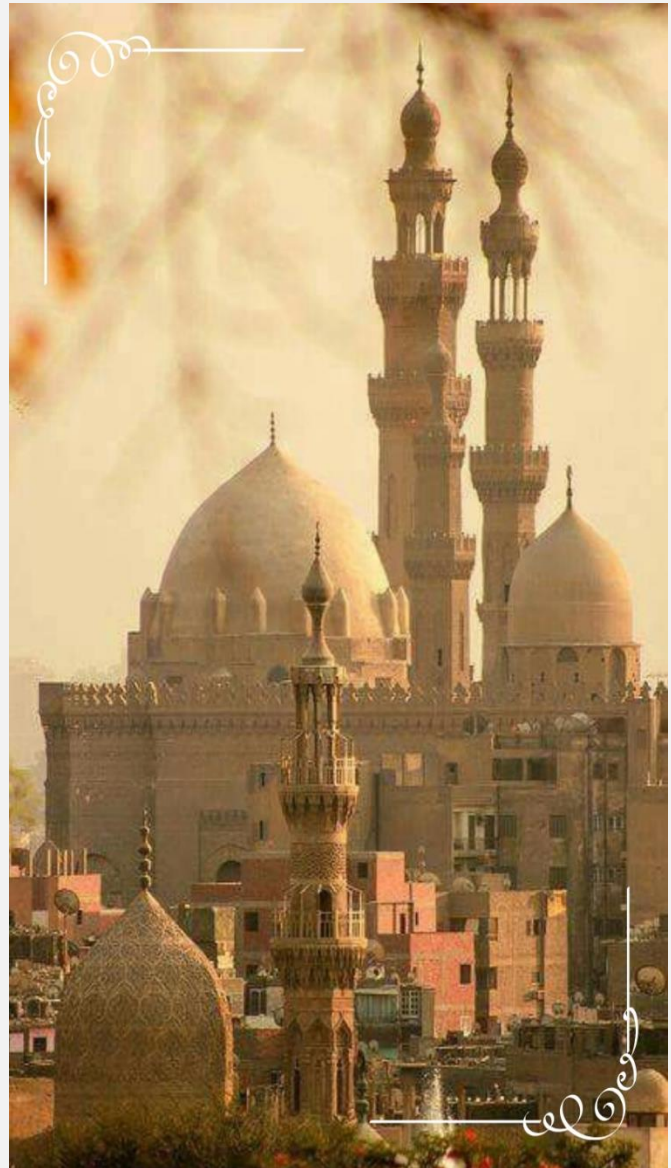
## DAY 01

## SOFITEL GEZIRAH HOTEL

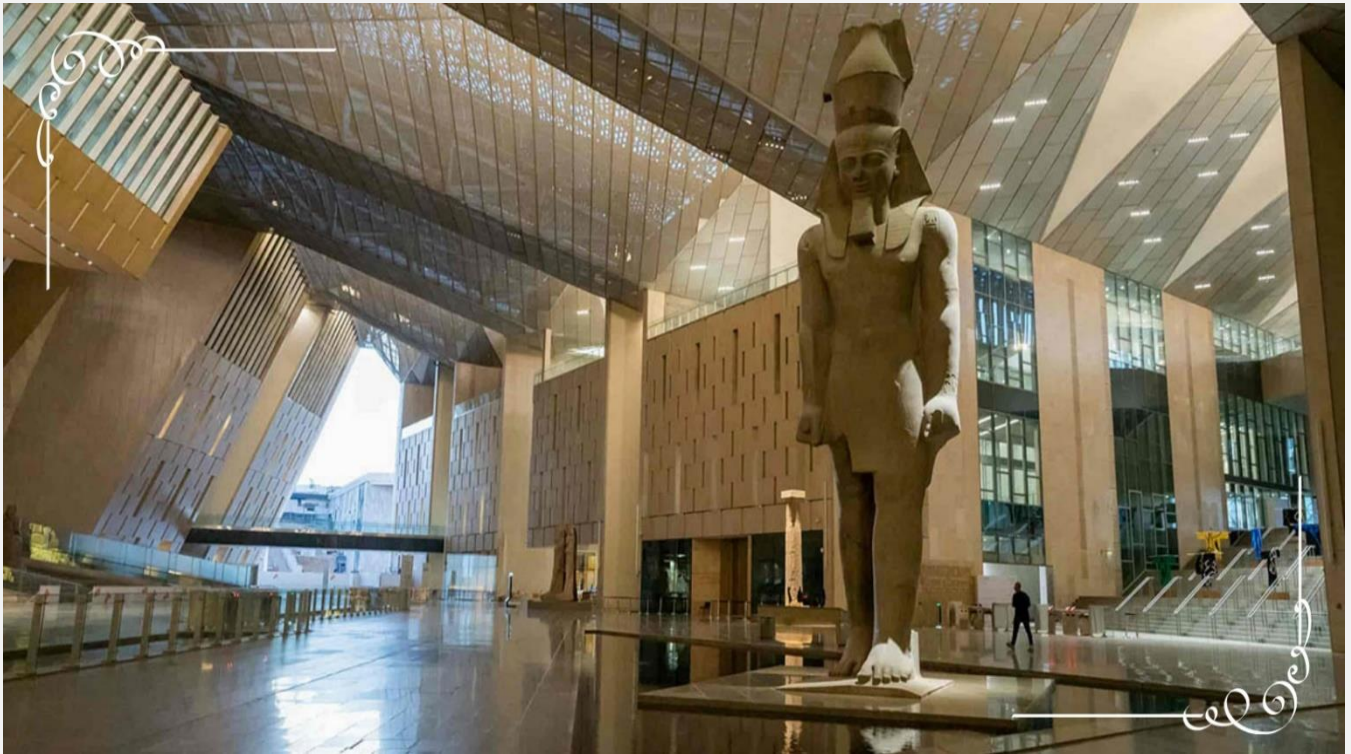
The Luxury 5-star hotel is located on Gezirah Island and right on the riverside in the heart of the world's oldest city

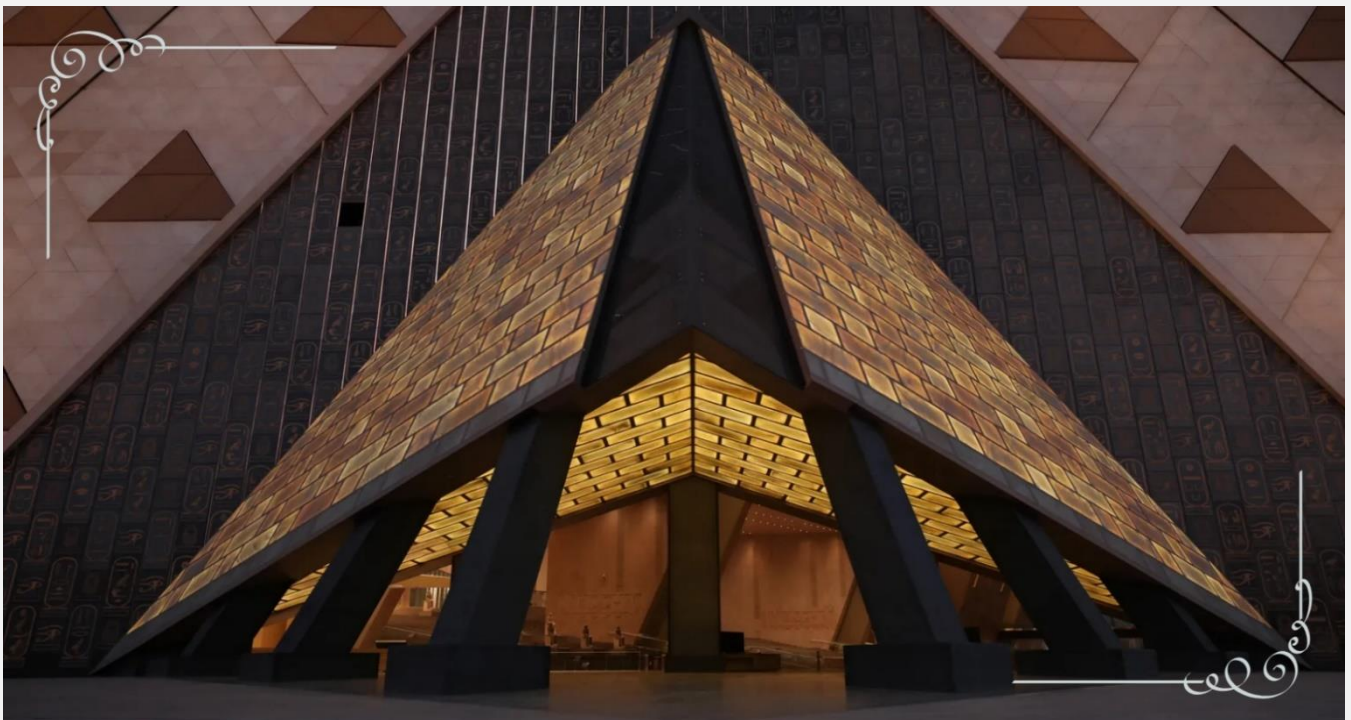

“The Great Pyramids”, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Explore the Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mykerinos). Marvel at the Great Sphinx, the guardian of the royal temples and the tombs. This massive limestone statue-the largest in the world-measures approximately 73 meters long and 20 meters high, featuring the body of a reclining lion and a head believed to be carved in the likeness of Pharaoh Khafre



Continue to the **Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM)**, also known as the New National Museum of Egypt, one of the largest and the most modern museums in the world. Located near the Pyramids of Giza, this global project encompasses the art, culture, and history of ancient Egypt. The interior displays a massive collection of over 100,000 artifacts. You will be awestruck by the colossal Statue of Ramses II, which stands over 11 meters tall and welcomes visitors at the entrance atrium. Enjoy cutting-edge technology such as AR and VR, which bring the ancient artifacts to life

Depart from Cairo Airport for your flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, proceed to the pier to embark on a Nile River Cruise. Enjoy the scenic beauty and magnificent ancient structures lining both banks of the world's longest river as you begin your sailing journey



## ASWAN

A city in southern Egypt located along the Nile River, it is a perfect blend of modern development and rich historical heritage. Furthermore, it is a member of the UNEXCO Creative Cities Network

Then visit the Aswan High Dam, constructed in 1960. This monumental engineering feat provides year-round irrigation for Egyptian farmland and generates essential hydroelectric power for the entire nation. Spanning 3,600 meters in length, the dam offers a panoramic view of Lake Nasser, the massive reservoir created by the damming of the Nile, which reaches depths of 80 meters and widths of up to 10 kilometers.





Next, continue to the Philae Temple (Temple of Isis), located on Agilkia Island in Aswan, is a magnificent World Heritage site dedicated to the goddess Isis.

In the 1960s, the temple was submerged due to construction of the Aswan High Dam. However, it was remarkably rescued by UNESCO between 1974 and 1980 through a monumental relocation project. The entire structure, consisting of over 50,000 stone blocks, was moved to its current location in Agilkia Island.

Recognized as one of the best-preserved Greco-Roman monuments in Egypt, Philae Temple remains a major must-visit destination, accessible today only by boat.

The cruise sails toward Kom Ombo, a city once known as the “City of Gold” due to its historical role as a vital trading hub for gold and goods from Nubia, the Eastern Desert, and the Red Sea. Today, this charming town has transformed into a flourishing agricultural center, renowned for its highly efficient and sophisticated irrigation systems



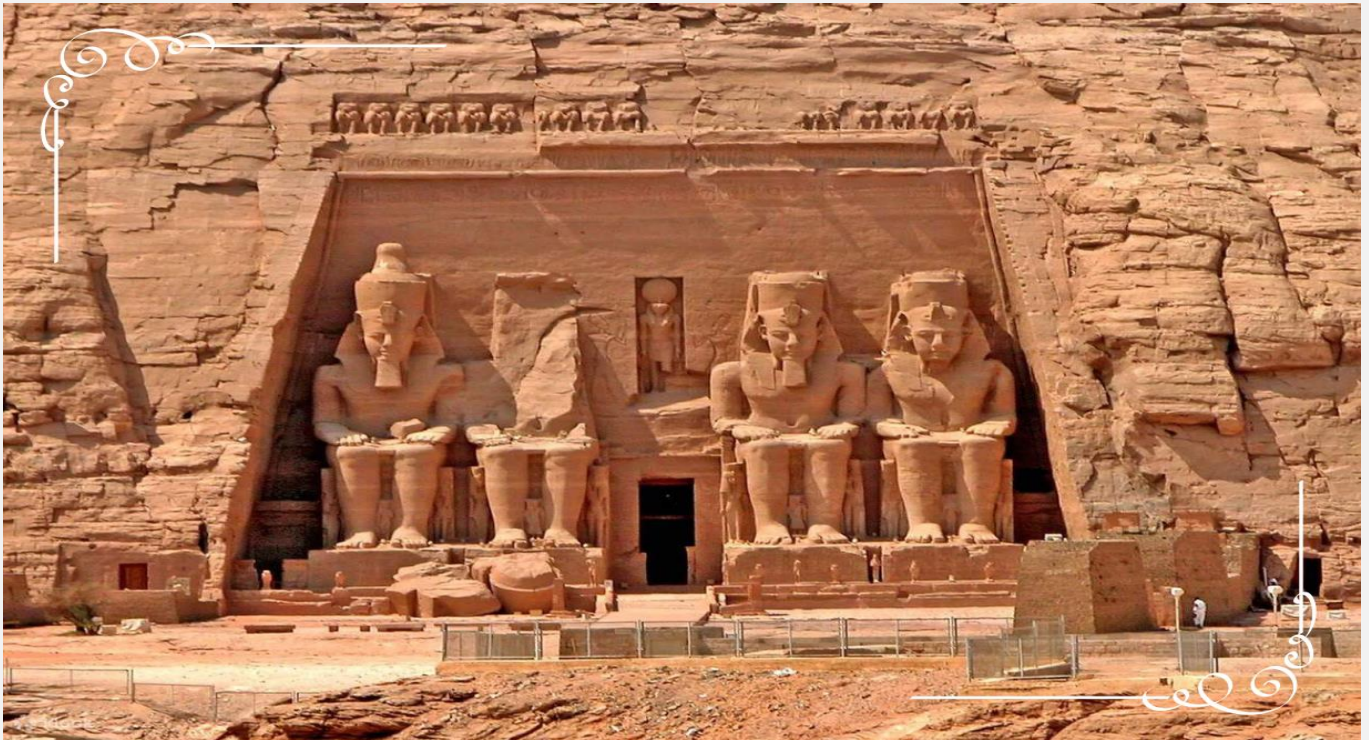
Visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, famously known as the “Double Temple”, perched on a low hill overlooking the Nile, this unique complex was built to honor two different deities. One side is dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile-headed god of fertility and the creator of the world. The other side is dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god of war and protection. This symmetrical design reflects the balance between these two powerful figures of ancient Egyptian mythology.



## OPTIONAL TOUR: ABU SIMBEL

*(Price is not included in the tour package)*

A city located in the Nubia region within the Aswan Governorate, situated on the shores of Lake Nasser. It's home to world-renowned rock-cut temples, which stand as one of Egypt's most significant UNESCO World Heritages sites



This ancient Egyptian grand temple was constructed by carving directly into a sandstone mountain. Inside, it features the rock-cut temple of Ramesses II, marked by four colossal statues of the Pharaoh seated on his throne, alongside the temple of Queen Nefertari, his beloved wife. It is widely known as the Temple of Ramesses, beloved of Amun

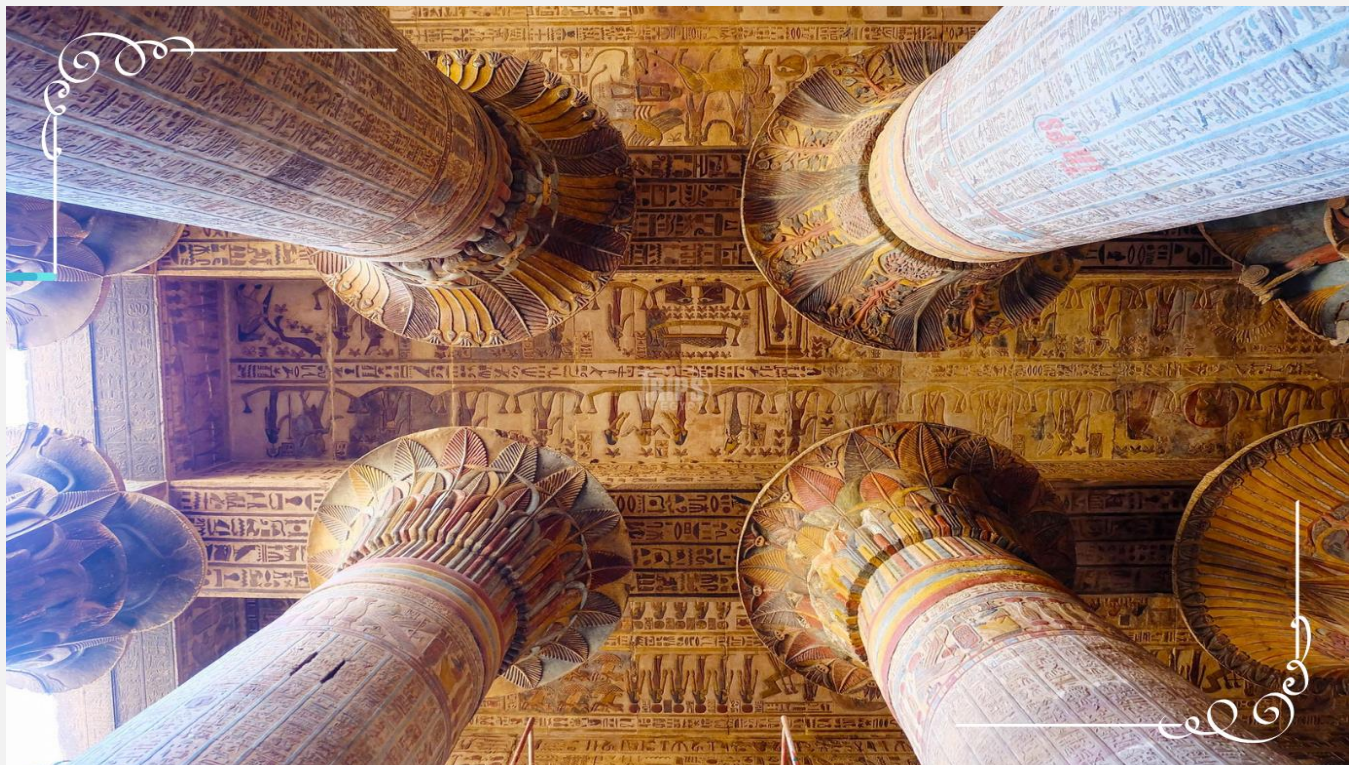


Arrive in Edfu and visit the Temple of Edfu (also known as the Temple of Horus). This magnificent complex is widely regarded as the most well-preserved ancient Egyptian temple in existence. Dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god, its colossal scale and intricate carvings remain remarkably intact

Then boat sails to a point where the Nile's water levels differ, known as the Esna Lock. The lock gates open to transition the vessel from the higher water level down to the lower level.



Afterward, return to the cruise to ship to continue sailing. Along the way, you will pass and view the Temple of Esna, and ancient sanctuary dedicated to Khnum, the ram-headed god of creation, who was believed to have fashioned humankind on a potter's wheel

Cross to the West Bank of the Nile, known in antiquity as the Necropolis of Thebes. This “City of the Dead” was believed by ancient Egyptians to be the realm of the afterlife and stands today as one of the world’s most significant archaeological sites

## OPTIONAL TOUR: HOT AIR BALLOON

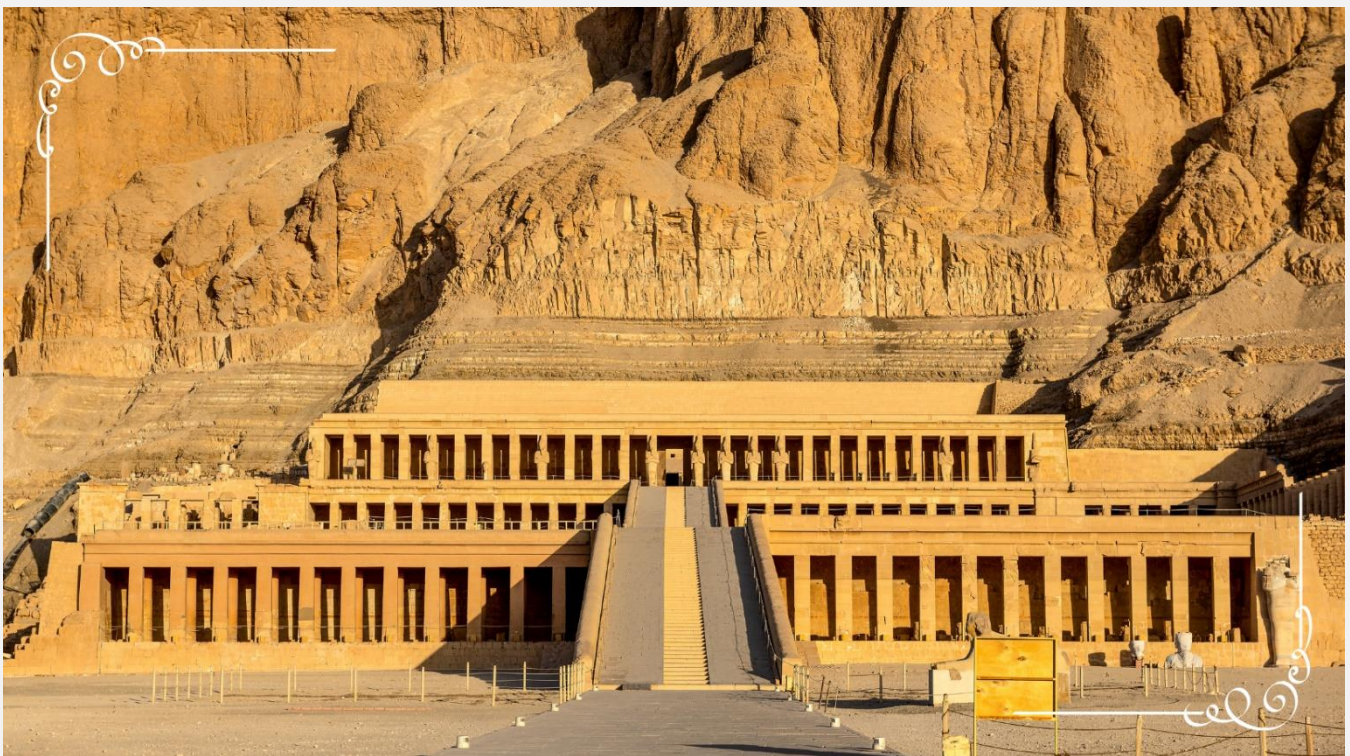


Take a hot air balloon ride over the skies of Luxor to enjoy a breathtaking bird's eye-view of the city

Explore the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of 63 Pharaohs. Nestled beneath the Theban Hills—whose natural peak resembles a pyramid—these rock-cut tombs were designed to safeguard royal mummies and immense treasures. The size and intricacy of each tomb reflect the length of the Pharaoh's reign, including the world-famous Tomb of Tutankhamun



Continue to the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut, a masterpiece designed over 3,500 years ago by the architect Senemut. This tiered temple honors Queen Hatshepsut, the most powerful woman of the ancient world. Known as the “Bearded Queen” for adopting traditional male pharaoh symbols, she was the only female Pharaoh to rule Egypt during a period of immense prosperity





Then explore Luxor Temple, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to Amon-Ra, the King of the Gods. Extensively excavated and restored beginning in 1883, the temple entrance features a massive pylon flanked by colossal granite statues of Pharaoh Ramesses II and his beloved Queen Nefertari. Marvel at the towering Obelisk, a grand red granite pillar intricately carved with hieroglyphics in praise of Amon-Ra, standing as a testament to the glory of the New Kingdom

After program, transfer to Luxor Airport to board your flight to Cairo Airport.

Upon arrival at Cairo Airport, transfer to Dinner at Local Restaurant. Then transfer to Sofitel Gezirah Hotel 5 star or similar

Travel to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NMEC) in Old Cairo. This landmark museum, officially opened on April 4, 2021, offers a comprehensive journey through Egypt's history from prehistoric times to the modern era. The Main Hall features over 1500 artifacts, including traditional textiles, models of ancient boats, and religious relics. A highlight of this hall is the Nazlet Khater skeleton, which dates back 35,000 years; it's displayed alongside the world's oldest known artificial limb, illustrating the remarkable medical advancements of ancient Egyptians. Experience the Royal Mummies Hall, the museum's crown jewel. Designed to evoke the atmosphere of the Valley of the Kings, this climate-controlled gallery houses 20 royal mummies-18 Kings and 2 Queens – including world-famous pharaohs such as Ramses II, Thutmose III and Queen Hatshepsut

Then visit The Hanging Church (Saint Virgin Mary's Coptic Orthodox Church), located in the heart of Old Cairo. Dating back to the 2<sup>nd</sup> century, it's the oldest Coptic Orthodox church in Egypt and remains a cornerstone of the Coptic Christian faith. The church's architecture is truly unique, featuring iconic twin bell towers topped with crosses. Its interior is famous for the wooden roof shaped like Noah's Ark, supported by 13 marble columns representing Jesus and his 12 disciples



Next, visit Citadel of Saladin, after the warrior leader who conquered Jerusalem, established the Citadel of Cairo to defend the city against Crusader invasions. We will take you to visit the Mosque of Muhammad Ali Pasha. Modeled after the Blue Mosque in Istanbul and located within the grounds of the Saladin Citadel, the landmark features grand Ottoman architecture. Its centerpiece is a magnificent central dome soaring 52 meters high, surrounded by an array of majestic semi-domes.





Conclude your journey with a shopping experience at Khan El-Khalili, the largest and most vibrant traditional souq (market) in Cairo. This historic bazaar offers a treasure trove of local goods and souvenirs. You can browse a wide array of exquisite handicrafts, including hand-blown perfume bottles, intricate gold and silver jewelry featuring Arabic motifs, gemstones, fine carpets and various traditional Egyptian keepsakes

After dinner at Local Restaurant, then transfer to Cairo Airport to board your flight back home.

## EGYPT VISA APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

*(Processing time: approximately 45 working days)*

1. **Thai Passports Only:** This service is reserved exclusively for Thai Passport Holders. For foreign passport holders, entry requirements are subject to the specific regulations of the Egyptian authorities
2. **Passport Copy & Photos:** A high-quality color scan of the passports first page (JPG or PDF format) must be submitted more than 45 days before departure. Photos must be 1.5 or 2 inches (white or blue background) and of professional quality; photo taken via mobile phone are not recommended
3. **Passport Validity:** Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the return date, with at least 2 blank pages. Please note that Office Passports (Blue cover) are not accepted for this group visa
4. **Group Approval (Visa on Arrival):** This is a group pre-approval process for a Visa on arrival, which takes a minimum of 45 days to process. Additional information may be requested at the sole discretion of the Egyptian immigration authorities
5. **Refusal & Individual Application:** If your group approval is denied, the Company reserves the right to withdraw your group application. In such cases, you will be required to apply for any Individual Visa, with all additional fees and processing times subject to the Embassy's current regulations and discretion
